

## **Rules and regulations for Montreal Impact Foundation 50/50 draw**

### **ELIGIBILITY**

- Must be 18 years or older to purchase 50/50 tickets.
- The following individuals are not eligible to participate in the 50/50 raffle: all 50/50 staff and gameday volunteers, Montreal Impact Foundation employees and their immediate family members, Montreal Impact Free 2 Play IT Department employees assigned to the activation of the raffle, employees of the company supplying the draw technology, and individuals serving on the Montreal Impact Foundation Board of Directors.

### **TO ENTER**

- Ticket buyers receive a printed receipt listing their numbers associated with their purchased tickets. The corresponding individual tickets are printed simultaneously in a secure room at Stade Saputo.
- Tickets are 1 for \$5, 3 for \$10, 15 for \$20 or 40 for 40\$.
- Ticket sales will take place only in Stade Saputo, at 4750 Sherbrooke East, Montreal, QC.
- Ticket sales start at the opening of the doors and end at the 55th minute. Sellers are located inside Stade Saputo, in different locations. Vendors are easily identifiable, wearing lime-green shirts.

### **DRAWING AND NOTIFICATION OF PRIZE WINNER**

- Chances of winning depend on the total number of tickets sold.
- Tickets are subject to verification by 50/50 organizers. All fraudulent tickets will be automatically removed from the draw and furthermore rejected from any chance of winning.
- The draw will be carried out during the 2nd half of the game.
- The winning number will be announced and displayed on our giant screens on a regular basis over the 15 minutes following the draw. In the event where the advertised number (displayed) and the official winning number are not identical, the latter shall prevail.
- The prize will consist of 50% of the total amount raised and announced (jackpot). In the event of a discrepancy between the announced (displayed) amount and the official amount raised, the latter shall prevail.
- If the winner does not claim their prize within the time limit mandated by the *Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux* (RACJ), a second winning number will appear on the scoreboard.
- The game's winning number and the total amount will also be posted at the 50/50 kiosks below sections 132 and section 126. The game's winning number and the amount will be available on the Foundation's website at [www.fondation.impactmontreal.com](http://www.fondation.impactmontreal.com) or by calling 514-328-3668 the day following the game (Monday for weekend games).
- The person whose number was drawn during the game must present themselves at the 50/50 kiosk under section 132 in order to claim their prize within 15 minutes following

the display of the winning number (according to RACJ regulations). The Montreal Impact Foundation assumes no responsibility to any other person claiming an interest or right to the whole or part of the prize associated with the winning ticket.

- Prize is paid by cheque and will be mailed within 15 business days of the winner claiming the prize.
- The winner must complete a declaration and release form before taking possession of their prize.

#### **OTHER GENERAL CONDITIONS**

- In the event that the electronic 50/50 system is unavailable at time of sale due to technical difficulties or otherwise, the Montreal Impact Foundation reserves the right to sell paper tickets instead of the electronic system. Paper tickets will be numbered in sequential order and sold in denominations of 1 for \$5, 3 for \$10, 15 for \$20 or 40 for 40\$. A random ticket will be drawn at the beginning of the second half, selected by someone who had not purchased a ticket for that particular draw.
- If the electronic system experiences detrimental technical difficulties during a game (i.e. at any time after sales for the game have commenced), 50/50 sales will immediately be suspended for the remainder of the game. If the Montreal Impact Foundation is able to verify that all tickets purchased prior to the suspension of ticket sales have been printed, the raffle will proceed and a winner will be announced in the second half. If the Montreal Impact Foundation is unable to verify that all tickets purchased prior to the suspension of ticket sales have been printed, the raffle will be postponed until the Montreal Impact Foundation is able to make such a verification. When a raffle has been postponed, the Montreal Impact Foundation will announce the winner as soon as possible and will post the winning number as indicated above.
- The Montreal Impact Foundation, Free 2 Play, Stade Saputo and any presenting sponsors and partners of the 50/50 program will administer the program in good faith and in the best interests of the Foundation. None of the partners (nor any employee or representative of any of the foregoing) shall be liable at any time for any errors, system malfunctions or decisions made in connection with the administration of the program.
- All winners release the Foundation, its partners, employees, or any other agents from any responsibility of damages incurred by accepting or using their prize.
- This 50/50 program is subject to all laws and all applicable federal, provincial and municipal rules. The decisions rendered by the organizers are final and without appeal in all aspects of the said raffle.

#### **PUBLICITY RELEASE**

- By participating in the 50/50 draw, the winner authorizes the right to print, publish or broadcast their name, portrait, picture, voice, likeness, and biographical information for any purpose without any form of compensation, including but not limited to, advertisements, publicity, and other communications without additional compensation, except where prohibited by law.
